**ORDER OF SUMMARY REVOCATION**

---

On July 2, 2008, the Staff of the Office of the Secretary of State, Securities Division, filed a Petition for Order of Summary Revocation ("Petition") against Respondent Real Estate Mortgage Corp., alleging violations of the Indiana Loan Broker Act ("Act"), Ind. Code 23-2-5 (2007), to wit: operating a principal loan broker office while employing an unregistered principal manager in violation of Ind. Code § 23-2-5-10(c)(5) and 20.5(b).

The Securities Commissioner ("Commissioner"), after reviewing the Petition and being duly advised, finds that grounds exist under the Act to order the revocation of the loan broker license of Real Estate Mortgage Corp., license no. 07-0122 LB.

Based upon the information presented, the Commissioner finds that a substantial threat of immediate irreparable harm exists, and that it is in the public interest to order the revocation of the loan broker license of Real Estate Mortgage Corp., license no. 07-0122 LB.

The Commissioner therefore ORDERS that the loan broker license of Real Estate Mortgage Corp., license no. 07-0122 LB, is hereby, summarily REVOKED. The revocation shall be deemed effective on August 5, 2008, and shall run continuously thereafter, unless Respondent: (a) becomes compliant with Ind. Code § 23-2-5-20.5(b) prior to August 5, 2008, or (b) files a written statement requesting a withdrawal of its license.

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 23-2-5-10(e), upon written request, this matter will be set for a hearing, commencing within fifteen (15) days after the receipt of the request.
