**ORDER OF REVOCATION**

---

The Office of the Secretary of State – Auto Dealer Services Division (“Division”) has filed a Petition for Order of Revocation against Respondents, Motorsports, Inc. (“Motorsports”) and Muntaser Habish (“Habish”), alleging certain violations of the Indiana Motor Vehicle Manufacturers, Distributors, and Dealers Act, Indiana Code 9-23-2, and requesting, *inter alia*, that the Indiana Securities Commissioner (“Commissioner”) issue an order revoking license number 600826 issued to Motorsports and Habish.

The Commissioner, having reviewed the Petition for Order of Revocation and being duly advised, finds that grounds exist under the Act for ordering that Motorsports’ and Habish’s license be temporarily revoked. The Commissioner further finds that such an order is in the public interest.

The Commissioner therefore ORDERS that license number 600826 issued to Motorsports and Habish is hereby TEMPORARILY REVOKED. A denial, suspension, or revocation of a license “remains in effect until the secretary of state: (1) modifies or vacates the summary order; or (2) conducts a hearing and issues a final determination.” See Indiana Code § 9-23-2-14(e).

The Commissioner further finds that grounds exist under the Act to order Motorsports and Habish to show cause as to why Motorsports’ and Habish’s dealer

license, number 600826, should not be revoked and to show cause as to why an order should not be issued denying any future license of Motorsports and/or Habish.

The Commissioner therefore ORDERS that Motorsports and Habish file a written answer or other response to the Petition for Order of Revocation within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this Order.

The Commissioner further ORDERS that the Respondents may submit a written request for an earlier hearing date pursuant to Indiana. Code § 9-23-2-14(d)(3). This matter will be set for a hearing within fifteen (15) business days after receipt of such request.
